INTERNATIONAL CLINICAL LABORATORY WEEK

International Clinical Laboratory Week is an event or observance that promotes awareness and recognition of the contributions made by clinical laboratories and laboratory professionals in healthcare. It is celebrated all over in April 22-27. This year observation under the theme: 'Medical Laboratory Professionals get results', then it is useful for me to share with the public aspects of the operating environment that are necessary in such a vital service.

The main objectives of International Clinical Laboratory Week include: Raising awareness: Educating the public and healthcare professionals about the importance of clinical laboratories in disease diagnosis, treatment, and prevention; recognizing laboratory professionals: Acknowledging the dedication and expertise of the individuals working in clinical laboratories; and Promoting quality and safety.

KMCT college of Allied health sciences celebrated the international clinical laboratory week on 21st April 2018 with varieties of activities. The programme was inaugurated by Prof. Santheep S (Principal, KMCT CAHS). The students of Bsc.MLT conducted a survey on and blood grouping programme for the neighborhood community. It was a beneficial programme for those who have difficulty to go to a clinic or hospital to know their blood group. All the details were documented and a detailed analysis of average blood group percentage also done. They have also conducted a poster presentation competition and the winners were appreciated. Fifty five students and ten teachers were participated.





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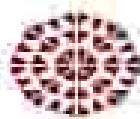
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OPTOMETRY CAMP

KMCT CARS has conducted an optometry camp at Maveer panchayath ward 9,10,12 on 7th and 8th may 2018. The programme was coordinated by department of optometry. The students of B.Sc optometry were actively participated in this programme and about 150 persons of this community

Thirty five students and three teachers were participated.





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OPTOMETRY CAMP

KMCT CAHS has conducted an optometry camp at municipal bus stand mukkam on 23rd July 2018(Wednesday). They have assessed number of persons with visual impairments and suggested correction glasses to them. 13 patients were referred to KMCT ophthalmology Department for further evaluation. The programme was conducted in collaboration with KMCT Medical college and Mukkam municipality.

Thirty five students and two teachers were participated.





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OPTOMETRY CAMP

Department of optometry has conducted a camp on 22nd August 2018 at Manassery (Ward 12,13). This programme was conducted in collaboration with Mukkan municipality. Our students assessed hundreds of people around the neighborhood community and Various visual defects are examined.

Twenty nine students and three teachers were participated.





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INTERNATIONAL PHYSIOTHERAPY DAY

On the occasion of international physiotherapy day, the students of KMCT CAHS has conducted physiotherapy assessment camp at SPINE orthosis and prosthesis, Manjeri (Malappuram dist.) on 8th September 2021. About 80 patients were evaluated and orthosis and prosthesis are given at low cost. The students took an awareness session about the maintenance of orthosis. Through this programme our students have got a chance to know about different types of orthosis & prosthesis.

Thirty students and six teachers were participated.





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WORLD HEART DAY

World Heart Day takes place every year on September 29. The celebration, founded by the World Heart Federation in 2000, offers people across the globe the opportunity to take part in the world's biggest intervention against cardiovascular disease.

On the occasion of world heart day 2018, the students of KMCT CAHS have conducted a cardiac monitoring camp on 29th September 2018 (Saturday). Themukkam municipality ward 13 members got opportunity to measure their blood pressure in their door step and valuable suggestions also given by our students.

Two hundred and sixty eight students and fifteen teachers were participated.

To help spread awareness about the existence and impact of rheumatic and musculoskeletal diseases (RMDs), October 12 is marked as World Arthritis Day. On the occasion of World arthritis day 2018 the students of KMCT CAHS have visited SPINE orthosis and prostheses center, Mangeri. The students of Bachelor of Physiotherapy were assessed the conditions of arthritis patients and suggested proper orthosis for them. The programme was co-ordinated by Dr.Vijay Selvan (HOD Dept. of Physiotherapy) and college students union.

Thirty students and four teachers were participated.

Two hundred and sixty six students and sixteen teachers were participated.





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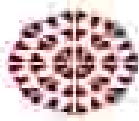
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WORLD DISABILITY DAY 2018 IN COLLABORATION WITH SPINE ORTHOSIS & PROSTHESIS MANJERI
