

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND REPORT

STUDENTS

In the survey, 33.5% of students expressed satisfaction with the KUHS syllabus for Allied Health Sciences, while 32.4% did not respond to the question.

Approximately 26.5% of students felt that the syllabus needed updating, and 7.6% did not provide any comment.

Furthermore, 46.9% of students agreed that the current curriculum met their expectations and adequately covered current techniques and modern tools.

Additionally, 47.6% of students agreed that the syllabus struck a good balance between theory and application.

A majority of 68.7% of students believed that the depth of the course was sufficient to achieve meaningful learning outcomes.

Furthermore, 59.6% of students agreed that the syllabus helped them tackle cases requiring a multidisciplinary approach.

On the other hand, 36% of students considered the patient exposure received during the course to be average.

Lastly, 61.1% of students found the curriculum satisfactory in terms of developing knowledge and skills.

TEACHER

A majority of 88% of students agreed that the curriculum design adequately covered all relevant topics for the assigned subjects.

Similarly, 84% of students found the assessment practices used by the institution to measure student performance to be satisfactory.

Regarding medical emergencies, 72% of students believed that the curriculum provided enough training to handle such situations.

On the topic of timely coverage of the syllabus, 56% of faculty members agreed that it was possible within the allocated hours.

Furthermore, 80.8% of students felt that the curriculum was sufficient to achieve the desired course outcomes.


Additionally, 88.5% of students agreed that the curriculum design encompassed all relevant topics for the assigned subjects. This sentiment was echoed by 80% of students who also believed that the curriculum adequately covered the course outcomes.

Moreover, 76% of students agreed that the syllabus struck a good balance between theory and application.

In terms of developing technical knowledge and skills, 80% of students found the curriculum satisfactory.

Furthermore, 64% of students believed that the curriculum encouraged research and active student participation in learning programs.





Lastly, 68% of students agreed that modern medical practices were incorporated into the course.

EMPLOYERS

The employers unanimously stated that they have acquired sufficient expertise in their field and are well-informed about the ethical, legal, and social aspects as well as their professional obligations. They also possess strong soft skills and are highly motivated to continue learning throughout their careers.

Three-quarters of the employers reported that they demonstrate effective planning and successfully execute plans within the designated time frame. Similarly, 75% of them have knowledge about current techniques and modern tools, enabling them to handle medical emergencies proficiently.

Furthermore, 75% of the employers are adept at working within a multidisciplinary approach to accomplish tasks efficiently. They possess excellent communication skills, which allow them to contribute productively to team dynamics in the workplace.

PROFESSIONALS

All professionals agree that they are competent in basic procedures and are satisfied with the institution's assessment practices. Approximately 66.7% of professionals believe that the curriculum provides adequate training for handling medical emergencies. They also possess good communication skills with patients and agree that the curriculum effectively develops technical knowledge and skills. Similarly, around 66.7% of professionals feel that the curriculum sufficiently covers course outcomes and maintains a good balance between theory and application. Additionally, all professionals agree that the curriculum promotes research, encourages active student participation, and incorporates modern medical practices.

ALUMNI

Approximately 54.8% of alumni agree that the curriculum is sufficiently updated and meets their expectations, enhancing their employability. Similarly, 61.9% agree that the syllabus strikes a good balance between theory and application.

Around 59.5% of alumni find the syllabus adequate for learning about current techniques and modern tools, as well as for addressing cases requiring a multidisciplinary approach.

Regarding patient exposure received during the course, 45.2% have a satisfactory opinion.

An overwhelming majority of 83.3% acknowledge that the syllabus adequately covers medical ethics.

Additionally, 76.2% of alumni admit that the curriculum effectively develops their knowledge and skills.


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Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report

To track and assess its performance quality with respect to curriculum and curriculum-related concerns, the IQAC's Feedback Analysis Committee designs assessments and solicits feedback from its stakeholders. Students, faculties, employees, professionals and alumni all submitted feedback forms. For every stakeholder, a particular piece of feedback is targeted.

The curriculum's learning-related difficulties were addressed in terms of quality, competence, skills, and professionalism for the students.

The feedback for staff members covered topics such as curriculum outcomes, connections between course content and related reference materials, accessibility of such items in relation to the curriculum, evaluation procedures, and curriculum delivery, among other things.

Alumni were asked for feedback on whether the course content was adequate, whether the syllabus content was sufficient in light of contemporary professional standards, and whether the curriculum was designed with the development of self-directed learning and a problem-solving approach in mind. The information gathered by the IQAC was organized and combined in order to create the analytical report.

The analysis is performed annually and per parameter.

The points raised by all parties are taken into consideration with great care.

Feedback from Students on curriculum and course outcome:

- 1. Syllabi content needs to be improved in terms of quality.
- 2. Curriculum's relevance and applicability in everyday settings can be improved.
- 3. The students want more hands-on training sessions.

Action taken

The problem was brought to the attention of all the teachers, who were then urged to enhance the curriculum using more effective teaching-learning methods and techniques.

All HOD's received formal instructions from a competent authority regarding how to address the curriculum's applicability and make the necessary adjustments.

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Outcome

Teachers' efforts were successful as evidenced by their subsequent application. Staff members made an effort to connect the curriculum to actual problems. Staff members gave more attention to practicals, made their instruction more experiential, and added additional value-added courses to their curricula.

Feedback from Teachers

2. Teachers should be free to use cutting-edge teaching methods such as group discussions, practical demonstrations, and seminar presentations.

Action taken

- 1. All HOD's received official guidelines on how to handle the problems raised by the teachers in their comments.
- 2. To address the difficulties raised by the instructors through feedback, formal instructions were distributed to all HOD's by responsible authority.

Outcome

The relevant HOD's received the details of the feedback and developed the necessary awareness.

2. Teachers were urged to use innovative teaching methods, develop unique methods of education, and incorporate various clinical demonstrations.


Feedback from Alumni

Outcome

- 1. Staff paid more attention to have more field visits and thus gave exposure to students for field visits.
- 2. Staffs paid more attention to give more evidence based practical education

Feedback from Employer

- 1. Handling medical emergencies

Action taken

- 1. Formal instructions were circulated to all HOD's addressing the issue.
- 2. Additional training sessions were organized for the students in handling medical emergencies. These sessions focused on enhancing

their knowledge and skills in emergency response, first aid, and communication during critical situations.

3. A monitoring and evaluation system was implemented to continuously assess the effectiveness of the curriculum changes. This involved collecting feedback from students, conducting periodic assessments, and tracking the achievement of course outcomes.


Outcome
